The PUSD Bond Program Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) was formed in 2004 under the terms of State Proposition 39, following the approval of Prop A 2003. Among the requirements of State Proposition 39 are a specific listing of proposed sites where funds will be spent, a description of the improvements that will be made and the establishment of a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee to review the spending of Bond funds and report their findings to the general public.
