Building Dedication at Pittsburg High School

Pittsburg Unified School District (PUSD) has completed the construction of three new buildings at Pittsburg High School. Funded by Measure N, a 2014 G.O. Bond, and thanks to the generosity of the voters in Pittsburg, the District has added twenty-nine new classrooms to the Pittsburg High School campus. Eight of the newly constructed classrooms are science labs. The total project cost was \$29,210,355.59 and it took ten months to complete. The buildings cover a total of 57,488 square feet, accommodating approximately 900 students. A building dedication will take place to celebrate the new construction.
