WHEREAS, the City and School District are committed to working together to develop implementation action strategies that are coordinated and intentionally aligned; and

WHEREAS, programs such as Improve Your Tomorrow and My Brothers Keeper are important first steps in achieving the goals contained with the City of Pittsburg's Youth and Young Adult Services Master Plan and the Pittsburg Unified School District's Local Control and Accountability Plan; and

WHEREAS, the community passed Measure M on June 7, 2016 with the intent to help fund programs for the City's youth; and

WHEREAS, the School District receives funds from the State through the Local Control Funding Formula and other grants

WHEREAS, staff is recommending that the PUSD Board adopt a Pledge to Address Persistent Opportunity Gaps Experienced by Young Men and Women of Color in alliance with the City of Pittsburg.

NOW, THEREFORE, the School Board DOES RESOLVE as follows:

The City and Pittsburg Unified School District have a long standing, cooperative relationship working to improve opportunities for Pittsburg's youth.

The Board of Education commits to continue working with the City of Pittsburg to improve opportunities for Pittsburg's youth, through the Superintendent or her designee and the City Manager or his designee and through the joint 2x 2 Committee.

The Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
