RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE PITTSBURG UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

Resolution No. 22-37

Ensuring Access to Social-Emotional and Academic Supports for Students with Disabilities

<u>WHEREAS</u>, intentional planning and additional staffing is necessary to ensure that all school activities are accessible to all students, particularly students with disabilities;

WHEREAS, PUSD recognizes that students need and benefit from services that are offered outside of the classroom;

<u>WHEREAS</u>, many student activities, especially social and emotional support services, take place during lunch time, after school and off-campus, and can include peer to peer support, restorative justice circles, health and wellness services, complementary learning, enrichment activities and student leadership development; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, many students with disabilities require dedicated staff support and investment to access social-emotional and academic support services that take place outside the classroom.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Superintendent or her designee shall include, as part of the budget and LCAP proposed for the 2023-2024 school year and subsequent years, investments to ensure social-emotional support and academic enrichment services are accessible to students with disabilities;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Superintendent or her designee shall research the root causes of any barriers to access of students with disabilities from social-emotional and academic support services and shall include potential solutions and required investments in the CCEIS plan and LCAP to address any such barriers;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the CCEIS Stakeholder committee has identified strategies for addressing barriers for students with disabilities, which should be considered as part of the plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the updates to the CCEIS plan shall be communicated to the Board of Education, and shall incorporate input from the CCEIS stakeholder group; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: the Board shall receive annual updates on the progress of the All of Our Students Succeeding Plan developed in 2016; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Data presentations will include students with disabilities as a student group in all data presentations.
