WHEREAS, comprehensive developmental school counseling programs are considered an integral part of the educational process that enables all students to achieve success in school;




Be It Further Resolved, That the Board of Education directs the Superintendent to post a copy of this resolution at each School Site and at the District Office for the public to view.
