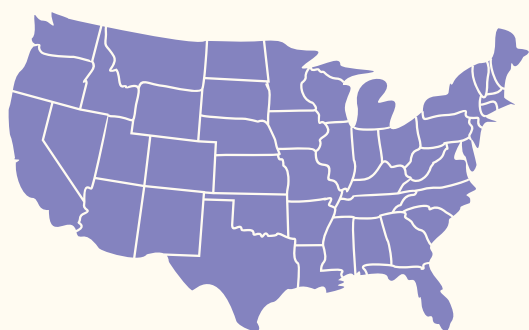

Financial Aid at Alder GSE

\$20,000

GOLDEN STATE TEACHER GRANT

Golden State Teacher Grant available to residents of up to \$20,000 who teach in a high-need field as defined by the state of CA (STEM, SPED, English, Multiple Subject, Bilingual Education) and commit to teaching in a high-needs school for 4 years.



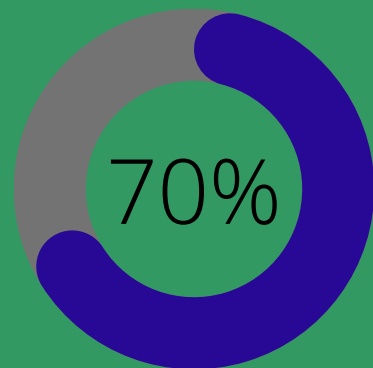
\$5,658 TEACH GRANT

Federal TEACH Grants available to residents of up to \$5,658 who teach in a high-need field (STEM, SPED, Multiple Subject, Bilingual Education, World Language, Language Arts) and commit to teaching in a high-needs school for 4 years.

Alder GSE Residency Scholarships

\$3K-\$10K

Need based tuition scholarships from Alder GSE ranging from \$3,000- \$10,000 are available. Last year 70% of scholarship applicants received a tuition scholarship.



UP TO \$49,000

We support students through the process of applying for Federal Loans when needed. Loans are available to bring total financial aid up to the Cost of Attendance (~\$49,000).

\$40,000 Living Stipend
